Eleanor Lea Cossairt passed away at a local hospital in San Antonio, Texas on February 15, 2020, at the age of 82. She was born at Ft. Sam Houston, Texas, on November 27, 1937. She is preceded in death by her parents, CW O (ret) Arthur and Lillie Mary Cossairt. A native San Antonian, she graduated from Brackenridge High School as Valedictorian in 1956. Receiving a PTA McAllister Scholarship, she entered San Antonio College and received an AA degree in 1958. Transferring to Trinity University, she received a BA degree in 1960 and a MA degree in 1963 and did postgraduate work there to obtain various educational certificates. Miss Cossairt taught English and history at Highlands High School from 1960 to 1965, and retired after 35 years as a Texas educator. She also taught part time as an English instructor at San Antonio College. Miss Cossairt is survived by her husband Rodney O. Raney and other numerous relatives and friends.
