



## Eleanor Nesloney

January 10, 1914 - January 4, 2011

Eleanor Rosa Nesloney, 96, of San Antonio, Texas, died January 4, 2011, surrounded by her family. She was born January 10, 1914, in Winters, Texas. She graduated from Winters High School in 1932, and subsequently graduated from the Abilene Beautician College. With the outbreak of World War II, she moved to San Antonio, Texas to work at Kelly AFB, as an aircraft inspector. One of the “Kelly Katies”, her primary job was to inspect and run up the engines on B-17’s bound for Europe. This ignited her interest in flying, and led to her student pilot license in 1944. She married John S. Nesloney, Sr., on September 29, 1945. They settled in San Antonio, Texas. Eleanor became a charter member of the Good Shepherd Lutheran Church. She served in the Women of the Church, as well as the Altar Guild. She was an active member of the Lutheran Hospital’s Auxiliary, and was a lifetime member of the National Association of Retired Federal Employees. She was an avid gardener, and seamstress and a bowler. Eleanor is survived by her children, John & Mary Nesloney, Jr., Ralph & Martie Wayne; Bob & Debbie Billa; Sister, Edwina Adami, of San Antonio, Texas; 5 grandchildren, and 2 great-grandchildren.
