



Eleanor "Nora" Frances Kowalik

October 4, 1916 - April 1, 2015

Eleanor "Nora" Frances Kowalik age 98 of Boerne, TX, met her Lord and Savior and was reunited with her loved ones on Wednesday, April 1, 2015.

She was born on October 4, 1916 to Julian and Sophie Bronder Moy in Cestohowa, TX. Her early life was spent helping her parents, 2 brothers and 4 sisters with farming to provide a living during the Depression years.

She met and married John Chester Kowalik on July 12, 1938 in Poth, TX with Fr. Dragon, John's uncle presiding.

John entered the U.S. Army Air Corps and while he was stationed in the U.S., she traveled with him through the Pacific Northwest. While he was stationed in England during the war, Eleanor worked at the Base Exchange at Lackland AFB and gave birth to their first daughter, Mickey. Eighteen months later, Eleanor introduced John to his daughter.

She was a housewife and gave birth to a second daughter, Betsy. The family then moved to South Bexar County where Eleanor became very involved in the community of Losoya and Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Church Villa del Carmen.

She spent the last 18 years of her life in Boerne, where she spent many hours

volunteering at the Rainbow Center and the Family Service Bureau having volunteered over 2000 hours. Eleanor was an active member of St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband of 50 years of marriage, brothers, Felix and John Moy, sisters, Julia Kortz and Susie Kortz, sisters-in-law, Theresa Kenedy, Maggie Laskowski and Lottie Southard and brother-in-law, Joe Kowalik.

Eleanor is survived by her daughters, Mickey Jack Johnson and Elizabeth Windle Lee; grandson, Christopher; two sisters, Bernice Keller and Mary Wiatrek; sisters-in-law, Sue Bickerstaff and Flossie Kryk; numerous nieces and nephews; and her canine companion, Mac.
