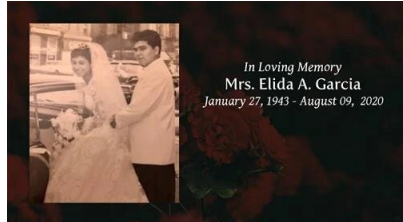

“*Elida was my sister, and I have a lifetime of memories to share! After my son left my home, I was basically alone with my dog. Elida knew this and would invite me over for coffee and food. We started watching movies and old tv series together. Sometimes her husband would watch movies with us too. It was a fun thing to do and I enjoyed spending time with them There were many times when we just sat at the kitchen table, and drank coffee as she shared whatever “food goodie” she had received from her daughters. She started telling me what I call “family stories.” She would share her life experiences from an earlier time. I would sit and listen, and I learned a lot about my family’s life before I was born. This was one of my favorite things to do with her! As my family was large (4 girls and 3 boys) my two eldest sisters sacrificed their education and youth, in working odd jobs and taking care of the younger siblings. They learned how to cook and clean at very young ages; making them wonderful cooks! My sister Elida knew that I liked home made tortillas, and she would always have some to share during our “talks” or movie time. I spent so much time with my sister that I had my own favorite chair and blanket, Sometimes we would be extravagant and shopping at the grocery store or dollar store. It is her loving, caring, and unselfish ways that I loved her so much. I am really going to miss you, Elida. There were so many other stories that were left untold.
