



Elizabeth (Betty) Cathern Reinhard

November 12, 1926 - November 3, 2018

Elizabeth (Betty) Cathern Reinhard, nee Conn, was a beloved and devoted mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. Adhering to her Christian lifestyle, she instilled guiding principles that would set her daughters on a lifelong path of virtue and wisdom. Throughout her life many were touched by her warmth and kindness, and in her passing she will be missed. Her departure from this life came at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, 3 November 2018 at the Brookdale Assisted Living Facility in Irving, Texas. She would have been 92 years of age on 12 November. Her passing at age 91 brought to a close a full life that was well beyond normal life expectancy. Although she is surely missed by the loved ones that she left behind, she is surely welcomed by her Heavenly Father and her husband Ernest, who preceded her in death a decade earlier.

Elizabeth Cathern Conn was born on 12 November 1926 to Hugh Lyttleton Conn and his wife Nora Conn (nee Neal) in Hoxie, Kansas. She was born into a large family. Several of her cherished siblings preceded her in death. They are Grace Breed, Richard Conn and Billie Lois Parr. Her beloved living siblings are Carol Armstrong, Mary Mitchell, Jim Conn, John Conn and Emily Skillman.

Betty's family eventually moved to Austin, Texas. During the World War II years she earned a bachelor's degree at the University of Texas, where she

worked part-time in order to finance her education. It was there that she met her lifelong spouse, Ernest Albin Reinhard. He had been a fighter pilot with the United States 8th Air Force, and after the war had continued his studies at the university. Ernest and Betty were married in 1949 and spent the next 59 years of their lives together in San Antonio.

After her daughters finished their education Betty embarked on a new adventure. She became an elementary school teacher and taught more than 15 years in San Antonio. She also learned to play the piano, which was one of her lifelong dreams.

Betty and Ernest were faithful members of Castle Hills Baptist Church; they loved to recount the many good times they had with their church friends.
