Elizabeth Ann Kondoff age 83 of San Antonio went to be with the Lord on Sunday, February 24, 2019. She was born August 22, 1935 in San Antonio to William and Anna Ruth Collett. She was a 1952 graduate of Brackenridge High School. Ann and her husband, Buddy are founding members of St. Matthew's Catholic Church and was active in many ministries there. She chaired the annual Assumption Seminary Wild Game Dinner. She was a member of the San Antonio Conservation Society and also chaired a booth at NIOSA. While raising their children, Ann and Buddy spent many family summers at Balboa Courts in Rockport and Camp Riverview on the Frio River. She was a longtime Secretary at Antonian High School. Ann and Buddy owned Broadway Locker from 1983 to 1989; after which they retired to live in Rockport where she was the Assistant to the Pastor, Monsignor Louis Kihneman at Sacred Heart Catholic Church. While there she was active in the ACTS Community and Columbian Ladies. Ann was a survivor having conquered breast cancer in 1985. She loved people, volunteering, the great outdoors, traveling with family and friends, fishing and gambling. Ann was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother, sister and friend; she will be missed by all who knew and loved her.
