Elizabeth E. Sienkiewicz nee Elston passed away Friday, October 12, 2007 at the age of 84. She was born at Ft. Moultrie South Carolina, on June 16, 1923, the daughter of George Elston and Lucia Pascal. She grew up in Gulfport, Mississippi. Mrs. Sienkiewicz attended Harrison-Stone-Jackson Junior College in Perkinston, Mississippi and graduated with special honors on 1942. She enlisted in the WAVES during WWII and served in the USN reserves until 1952. In 1975 she and her husband, Lt Col Henry V Sienkiewicz deceased retired to San Antonio, where she worked in the 5th Army Inspector General's office at Ft. Sam Houston until her retirement in 1989. She is survived by her daughters, Lucia Jameson and husband Tom, and Meta Sienkiewicz, and sons Raymond Sienkiewicz and wife Sook, Michael Sienkiewicz and wife Zelma, and Robert Sienkiewicz and partner Freddie Borders.
