May 28, 1915 - January 27, 2010

She was born on the unseasonably snowy day of May 28, 1915 to Edward and Alice McBride on the family farm north of Brewster, Kansas, a 320 acre homestead she still owned at her passing. Ella attended Kansas Wesleyan University where she met her husband, Virgil Baer. They married on a memorable 118 degree day on August 16, 1936 and remained deeply in love until his death in 1993.
