Emanuel Salaiz, 86, of Boerne, Texas, died on Thursday, September 6, 2018. Born on May 25, 1932, in Kenedy, Texas, he graduated from Central Catholic High School in San Antonio in 1950, attended St. Mary's University and was an Air Force Korean War veteran. Emanuel lived and worked in San Antonio for over 50 years as a self-employed merchant, wholesaler and exporter. He spent the last 10 years of his life in Boerne in the house his daughter designed and built, as an active member of the Catholic Church community and a 4th degree member of the Knights of Columbus. Survivors include his wife of 62 years, Maria ("Mare"), daughter, Liz, son, Rich, his wife, Cathy Ward, and two grandchildren, Carina and Liana. He is also survived by his brother James.
