Manny Emanuel A. Ballard, born August 2nd, 1932, went home to The Lord Jesus Christ on June 9th, 2008 from complications of Parkinson's disease. He was born in Holy Cross, KY on August 2, 1932. Manny served as a member of The Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate from 1957 to 1982. He served in the Catholic Diocese of Brownsville, Texas and helped establish the Catholic Stewardship Program. Manny inaugurated the Catholic Marriage Encounter Program in Texas, Mexico, and helped establish this program in parts of Latin America and Africa. He served as Director of Oblate Missions, in support of Oblate Missionary work throughout the world. Manny was an active and loyal parishioner of St. Matthew's Catholic Church. He had a positive outlook as well as a robust zest for life. He enjoyed traveling, biking, cooking and entertaining friends and family. He is survived by his Wife of 21 years Elaine Ludwig Ballard; His son Robert G. Ballard; Daughters Carla Haley and her husband Greg, Druann Bosien and her husband Brian; Grandchildren Kevin Bosien, Kari Bosien, Devin Haley, Brooke Haley and Brandi Haley; sister Agnes Simms; brothers Ignatius Ballard, Frank Ballard, and Benny Ballard, as well as numerous nieces and nephews.
