



## Emil Akers

February 14, 1914 - June 25, 2006

Mr. Emil Akers, age 91, was born in Poteet, Texas on Valentine's Day in 1914; he passed away on June 25, 2006 after a brief illness. Emil earned a bachelor's degree from A & I, Kingsville, and in 1941 began a career in civil service at Kelly Field. Starting as a sheet metal worker, he helped keep our Air Force in the skies during WW II. He retired in 1972, having risen to an upper management level, in order to concentrate on his fishing, hunting and gardening. A lifelong active member of the Masons, he was presented his 70 year service pin this last year. He was Past Master of the Perfect Union Lodge #10, as well as an endowed member of the Davy Crockett and Lonnie Irvin Daylight Lodges. He held membership in the Scottish Rite, the Alzafar Shrine, and the Jesters as well. He is survived by his sister, Nellie Mae Mitchell; niece, Nell Mitchell and her husband Willy Pfannstiel; his caregiver and friend, Josie De La Rosa; and his dear cousins and many friends.
