Emmett “Richard” Womack went to be with Our Lord and Savior on 7/31/21. Born 7/20/40 in Bowie, Texas to Pauline Womack, he developed an early love of sports, outdoors and story telling. Richard attended Northside H.S. in Ft. Worth, Texas. Upon graduating high school he soon found his life long vocation in the outdoor advertising sign business.

In 1990, Richard started Media Displays, Inc. a full service outdoor advertising service company and in 1993 co-founded Media Outdoor Displays, Inc., which owns and operates billboards in San Antonio and south Texas. While both businesses were more than full time occupations, Richard found time to pursue other hobbies and interests. In the early and mid 1990’s, he won several world masters archery championships.

With the story telling influence of his great grandfather, Richard authored four books depicting the Texas Rangers, cowboys and the wild west. The books include “Ride the Ranger Winds”, “Ranger Winds, Ride On”, “The Last Ride”, and “Ranger Winds The New Breed”. Upon completing the books he focused his spare time on writing poems and appeared on several podcasts reciting some of his poems.

He will be remembered by his son and friends as a loving dad, never too busy to share his stories with others and willing to teach employees trade practices

and coach those willing to learn to shoot the bow.

He is survived by his son Richard Lee Womack and wife Inez Franco.

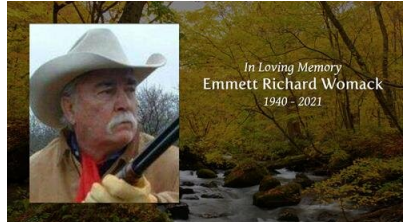
