Please do not send any flowers to the funeral home due to services being held at a later date.

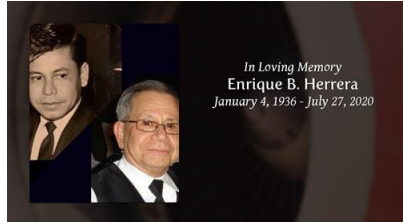

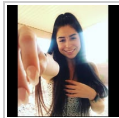
