



## Ernest Ray Wade

October 16, 1945 - August 19, 2005

On Friday August 19, 2005 Ernest Ray Wade of San Antonio, Texas passed away at his home of a fatal heart attack. He is survived by his wife of 39 years Vicki Wade and his two daughters Kelli Wade Kirwan married to MSgt Charles Kirwan and Kerri Wade Volk married to Michael P. Volk. His family includes eight grandchildren: Victoria Kirwan, Wade Kirwan, Rebekah Kirwan, Joseph Kirwan, Hannah Volk, Samuel Kirwan, Adam Kirwan, and Tyler Volk.
