Ernestine received her Reverend License through World Bible Way Fellowship and participated in many different Volunteer Ministries. She established two missions in Mexico to minister to the local communities. She ministered at the Dolph Briscoe Prison for 5 years, establishing a choir and baptizing many

prisoners. She ministered at the Baptist Hospitals comforting the sick and encouraging those who had lost loved ones to have faith in God. She ministered at the Ft Sam Houston AMEDD Chapel for 4 years.

Ernestine was involved in many community, neighborhood and city issues. She volunteered in the SANYO organization and rallied the community to support important matters that affected the safety and security of the Harlandale area.

Ernestine traveled the United States and the world, with her husband Alfredo, their children, grandchildren and other extended family members. She visited European countries and as far away as Australia. She visited Israel twice on a pilgrimage to trace the steps of Jesus.

Ernestine will be remembered for her dedication and love of God and her great passion for both her immediate and extended families.
