



Erno E. Wille

March 27, 1918 - December 12, 2006

Erno E. Wille was born on March 27, 1918, in Waring, TX to Herman Wille and Emma Marquardt and went peacefully in his sleep to his Lord on December 12, 2006. He was the 5th of seven boys and three girls. He went to Waring's two-room school house and graduated from Comfort High School in 1935. He married Marcella Hahn in July 1940 and started work at Camp Stanley. He spent three years in the U.S. Army and returned to Civilian Service at the Old S.A. Arsenal and then to S.A. General Depot on Ft. Sam Houston. In 1955 he transferred to Lackland AFB until his retirement in May 1973, after 33 years of civilian service. Mr. Wille continued his military service serving 33 years in the Texas Army National Guard, retiring as Chief Warrant Officer W-4, in 1976. Erno was a member of Hermann Sons, Elks Club, Jolly Dollar Club, Starlight Dance Club. His hobbies were fishing, hunting, golf, casino slots, but his true love was dancing and traveling the world. He is survived by his wife of 66 years, Marcella; his two daughters and son-in-laws, Adrienne and Ken King, Mavonne and Howard Kiesling; seven grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.
