Esequiel was born on April 11, 1941 to father Nick Campos and mother Manuela Campos who have preceded him in death. He grew up in a loving home along with his 2 sisters and 4 brothers.

Esequiel married his high school sweetheart at the age of 16; on February 16, 1958. They lived in San Antonio and raised their children on the city's south side. Esequiel strived in all he worked for. From hauling Christmas trees; to being a migrant worker. Esequiel became an entrepreneur early in life; when he opened up Campos Used Cars. In the early 80's he opened and established Campos Construction Company; which he and his son ran for many years. In the Mid 90's Esequiel and his wife opened and operated Palo Alto Flea Market; where the entire family pitched in and worked together for numerous years. He then became an active member of the San Antonio Charro Association; where he enjoyed riding his horses and participating in Fiesta Parades and other countless events.

Hard work was no stranger to Esequiel; his drive and work ethic was like no other. His love for his wife and children were behind his drive. Everything he did, he did 100% or not at all.

Besides his wife and children, Esequiel leaves behind numerous aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and in laws. He will be remembered for his quick wit and will be greatly missed by all who knew and loved him.
