She grew up in the southside attending Carroll Bell Elementary School, Terrell Wells Middle School and graduated from McCollum High School in 1987. She attended college at Southwest Texas State (SWT) where she graduated in 1992. She was also known as Mrs. Mosqueda to her students and co-workers at Vestal Elementary School where she taught for 29 years until she retired in 2021. Not only was she a teacher in the classroom, but she was a teacher to all about saving Mother Earth. She was a big advocate for always recycling and composting when you can. Also, she worked as a Mary Kay consultant to help empower her fellow sisters about feeling good and beautiful in their own skin. Her love for animals was known by all as she had many pet dogs, a cat, and a rabbit.
