Etta Jane was a beautiful person inside and out. She was so kind and compassionate. Etta Jane's favorite activities was spending time with her family and her many dogs and horses. Her canine companions were very near and dear to her. She was an accomplished horseback rider and taught all her children to be confident riders as well. All of us participated in horse shows, parades, gymkhanas, and many, many trail rides. Compassion for all animals has always been important to her. Some of her favorite charities include: Humane Society of Southern Arizona, Pima Animal Care Center, Best Friends Animal Society, Tiger Creek Animal Sanctuary, Jane Goodall Institute, and National Parks Conservation Association.

Another activity that was thoroughly enjoyed by Etta Jane was traveling in her RV! She travelled across the United States. Among her favorite destinations were Stow, Ohio, to visit her son Michael and the Redwoods National Park. When in Tucson, she could often be found camping on Mt. Lemmon at Spencer Campground with her friends and dogs.
