Eugene Arthur Flores passed away the morning of March 8, 2023, at the age of 102 years. He was born on December 28, 1920, to M.C. Flores and Elise Carvajal Flores in San Antonio.

A descendant of the Canary Islands and of the founders of San Antonio he graduated from Central High School in 1939 and attended Wake Forest University and San Antonio College.

He enlisted in the Air Force and served for 3 ½ years during WW II. After discharge he worked in the finance office at Randolph Air Force Base, later he worked at Kelly Air Force Base as a budget analyst with 34 years of service at retirement. He was predeceased by his wife of 76 years, Fay Wahl Flores, and brother Michael Flores.

He is survived by his daughter, Linda Flores, and numerous cousins. Gene's lifetime hobbies included golf, painting and travel. He enjoyed entertaining family and friends at his weekend home on lake LBJ.
