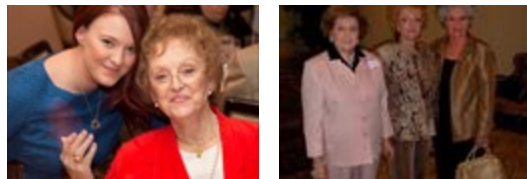
*From being Luby wives together and the card group, we all have a much larger family group. Not only were our parents friends, but the friendships have included us kids, and now the grandkids.*
