Eva De Hoyos Machado went to be with the Lord on March 24, 2024. She passed away peacefully in her “casita” where she lived for 63 years. She was born on January 4, 1928 in Rosebud, Texas to David De Hoyos of Mexico and Maria Gamez of Texas. Eva was preceded in death by her husband, Jose; her son, Jose “Pepe” Machado; her son David Machado and daughter Ana Machado Gonzalez. She is survived by son Hector Machado and his wife Kimberly Machado as well as her sister Berta Benavides. In addition, she has two daughters-in-law, one son-in-law, eight grandchildren and thirteen great grandchildren.
