Evangelina Garza Hernandez went home to be with God on July 8, 2020. She was born a tiny twin on December 20, 1937 with her brother, Jaime. One of 8 children, most of her siblings, her parents, her second child, Julio, her twin brother and her granddaughter Savannah were waiting in heaven to greet her. Her husband of 50 years, Samuel Ramirez Hernandez waited there for her as well.

She was a preacher's wife, and she gave the gift of faith to all her children. Her life was never easy, but she always had faith in God. Each day she woke with a song on her lips, ready to work in her garden, exercise with her Silver Sneakers class, read her Bible and pray. God and her family were the center of her life - she was a beloved mother to 6 children: Samuel, Moises, Jose Gabriel, Norma, Jonathan and Flor. Her proudest achievements were her grandchildren, who she adored: Daniel, Stephen, Emily, Natalie, Jon Michael, Joanna, Ethan, Anjulie, Isabella, Savannah and Christopher.

She learned at the age of 72 that she was a gifted painter - her canvases hang not in famous museums, but in the homes of her children. God always provided for her, and she made good use of what God gave her so there was always more left over to share with others. A faithful member of her church, University Park Baptist, where she served as Sunday school teacher, she sang a beautiful soprano in the choir, helped in the food ministry, and was

always ready to serve.

What she would most want for you, whoever you are, is that you know God and trust Jesus as your savior.

She is survived by her 6 children and their spouses, 10 grandchildren, and sisters Irene and Conchita.

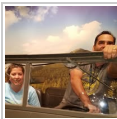
