Evelyn Gregorczyk of San Antonio, Texas, passed away peacefully with her children by her side on January 2, 2025 at the age of 76. Evelyn lived a full and vibrant life, dedicated to her family, friends and her career.

Evelyn was Born in Beeville, Texas on July 30, 1948. She spent her early years living and working on the family farm in Tynan, Texas, setting the foundation for her strong work ethic. She was a gifted all-around athlete in high school, earning All-State honors in basketball her Senior year.
