



## Evelyn A. Jordan

September 12, 1929 - May 23, 2017

Evelyn A. Jordan died peacefully on Tuesday, May 23, 2017. Born September 12, 1929 in San Antonio to the late Alvina Tondre and August Schuh, she graduated from Blessed Sacrament Academy. Evelyn attended business school and worked for American General Insurance Company before marrying the love of her life Lawrence Jordan on August 7, 1954. Evelyn often volunteered at St. Mary Magdalen school in the classroom, office and library. She worked in the family business, Jordan Plumbing Company, as a secretary and accountant. She was active with the school PTA, church Altar Society, Boy Scouts, and Texas Plumbing Heating Cooling Contractors Women's Auxiliary. Evelyn loved to bowl, play bridge, talk slot machines into letting her win, and explore the far corners of the world. Most summers were spent camping at Garner State Park or along the Texas Gulf Coast near Rockport where she liked to fish. Mostly she enjoyed spending time with family. She and Lawrence were among the founding members of the Holy Cross Guild through which they made life long friends. She will be remembered for her giving nature, quick smile, home cooked meals, cookies, and readiness to accept any invitation "to go".
