Evelyn Thompson Lindsey, age 93, of Jourdanton, TX, gained her wings Sunday, October 17, 2021. She loved her family and was ready to brag any time she had the chance. Reading a good book, especially the Bible, sewing (anything from doll clothes to old fashioned sun bonnets), eating homemade ice cream, visiting with friends & loved ones and riding around in the country on the golf cart were all things she loved to do. An owl hooting, turkey gobble or coyote howling in the distance were all familiar sounds she never tired of hearing.

She enjoyed the last 12+ years at Argent Court Jourdanton where she reconnected with cousins she hadn't seen in ages, former church friends from University Park Baptist Church in San Antonio, attended her original church home at Black Creek Baptist Church in Devine and even some former backyard neighbors from the medical center area of San Antonio.
