On August 7, 2013, peacefully said farewell to this earth at the age of 88 to join his beloved wife Carmen. Born in Corpus Christi, Texas on December 1, 1924 the youngest of 8 children. Felix was one of three brothers who were in the service at the same time. He was a three war decorated combat medic. His career in the Army spanned 26 years. He served honorably in WWII, the Korean Conflict and a two time tour in Vietnam. He was part of the 3rd Army that liberated the Dachau concentration camp in Germany. A German SS officer gave up his sidearm and surrendered to Felix. He is survived by daughters, Lydia Fouch, Beatriz Imken Cliff, Dolores Ramirez Jerry, and Mary Ann Harrington Sean, sons, Felix M. Guerra Jr. Vickie, Gilbert M. Guerra, Lorenzo M. Guerra, and Alfred Guerra Melissa, sisters Julia Rodriguez and Pat Perez, 16 grandchildren, and 15 great-grandchildren.

He was an avid golfer although the "hole in one" eluded him. He was an active member and former President of the San Antonio Senior's Golf Assn. He was a member of the Kirby VFW. Felix could have been a professional dancer and showed his talent every time the music played – a polka was his favorite but a mambo or waltz was always on his dance card.
