Fernando A. “Fernie” Muñoz entered into rest unexpectedly, June 7, 2007, at the age of 31 of an enlargement of the heart. He had a big heart as he cared for so many people and for many loved him. A beloved son, father, brother, uncle, nephew and cousin. As much as his love for his family and friends, was his love of the outdoors, especially deer hunting. Seldom seen at home during deer season, he was constantly in a deer stand, filling feeders or making improvements at deer camp. Fernie was a 1994 graduate of Robert E. Lee high School and went on to serve his country in the U.S. Army from 1996-2001 as an attack aviation and armorment specialist on the AH-64 Apache Helicopter. After an honorable discharge from military service, Fernie worked as an electrician with Lanehart Electric in San Antonio, where he leaves behind many friends. Along with his brother and nephew, these co-workers were often targets during paintball games. Fernie was a coach to his daughter’s volleyball team from St. Matthew’s Catholic School. He always found time after a 10 hour workday to help the girls he coached to be better players. Still a child at heart he got along so well with everyone because he could bring out the child in us all. He is preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, Bernabe and Claudia Zamudio and Aunt Sophia. Fernie is survived by his parents, Martha and Fernando Muñoz; daughter, Martha Felicia Muñoz; son, Gabriel Fernando Muñoz; grandparents, Pedro and
