Fidel also provided estate counseling and supported several families after they lost their loved one by ensuring they received their money: often walking them through the process of submitting their claim.

Fidel met the love of his life, Maria Magdalena Saenz, when he was twenty-five years old. Together they built a life of spiritual worship and family. Upon their marriage Fidel accepted Maria's family as his own. Throughout his life Fidel attempted to remain in contact with his nieces and nephews from both sides of his families. He and Maria were married for forty-nine years.

Fidel considered his three daughters, seven grandchildren and seventeen great grandchildren his greatest blessing. He shared his love of sports with his family, as well as his love of the outdoors. 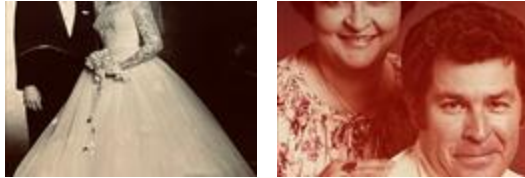
