



## Florence Pauline (Andreolli) Koble

July 2, 1920 - January 13, 2018

Florence Pauline (Andreolli) Koble, of San Antonio, Texas, passed away on Saturday, January 13th at 3:15 pm at Methodist Transplant Hospital ICU in San Antonio while convalescing from a heart attack complicated by Pneumonia. She was 97 years old.

Florence was born in San Antonio on July 2nd, 1920 to Emil John and Mina Pauline (Grenzen) Andreolli. She was the fourth of five children to be born to Emil and Mina. Her two brothers and two sisters, oldest to youngest, were Sonny, Frances, Dorothy and Alfred. She attended and graduated from Brackenridge High School in San Antonio. After graduation, Florence gained employment at Finesilver Manufacturing in S.A. and worked there until shortly before her marriage to Charles Joseph (Joe) Koble of Roseville, Ohio on July 31st, 1943 in South Zanesville, Ohio, and gave birth to her one and only child, Charles Jr. on June 22nd 1944 in Zanesville, Ohio.

Florence was a loving wife, mother, and grandmother. She sewed her own clothes and Joe's shirts. She was a wonderful cook. Her homemade bread, macaroni and cheese and chicken and dumplings were a taste delight. Nothing gave her greater pleasure than to have the entire family over for visits and her wonderful home cooked meals.

Florence is preceded in death by her husband, Charles J. Koble, Sr.; her oldest brother, Sonny; and her sisters, Frances and Dorothy. She is survived by her son, Charles J. Koble, Jr. and his wife, Nancy; her grandson, Kristopher Dillon Koble; her youngest brother, Alfred Andreolli and his wife,
