



## Frances E. (Dunne) Allpass

Frances E. (Dunne) Allpass, 92, of San Antonio passed away on June 23, 2021. Fran was born in Waterbury Connecticut. She attended Southwest Grammar School and Buckley High School in Hartford, Connecticut. She also attended Norwich Art School in Norwich, Connecticut.

In 1949 she joined the Hartford Insurance Group in the Burglary Department as an underwriter. Later in 1966 she was named Supervising Underwriter. She wrote three articles which were printed in the Hartford Magazine; 1) How's Your Burglary 1.0.? and 2) Information On Two Policies: Money & Securities Insurance, Mercantile Open Stock Insurance.

Both articles were reprinted in other magazines and used in the insurance classes at City College in New York City.

In 1976 Fran married Trafford Allpass, a very talented artist and in 1980 Hartford Insurance Group transferred her to San Antonio, Texas where she handled sales and traveled across the state. Also, in 1980, she won the company sales award. In 1987, Fran retired after 40 years with the Hartford Insurance Group.

In retirement she practiced calligraphy and made stained glass.

She is preceded in death by her husband of 40 years Trafford Allpass, parents Walter and Kathleen Dunne, Sister Mary Smith.

She is survived by her Niece Christine (Michael) Wall, Nephew Stephen Smith, Step-son Bob (Susan) Allpass and Grandson Erik (Erin) Stendebach.
