Frances Oleta Worley Huddle was born February 19, 1921 in Hardeman County, Texas. She was the youngest of three children born to Inez Crain and Luther Alphus Worley. She graduated from Chillicothe High School. She lived in Wichita Falls and Dallas before moving to San Antonio in the 1950's, where she met and married T.C. Huddle. Fran and T.C. moved to Castle Hills in 1961, where she lived until her death.

Fran was an accomplished bridge player and a wonderful chef and baker. Her baked goods were the most popular at any bridge event. She and T.C. often hosted parties for which she prepared wonderful food. Fran was a member of many bridge clubs and was always a popular partner. She was a good friend who was the first to arrive at any crisis with a casserole or cake. She was a long-time member of Covenant Presbyterian Church where she was active in the Women's Church Circle.

Fran was preceded in death by her parents, her brother, L.A. Worley, her sister, Thelma Worley Collins, and her nephew, Jerry Collins.
