



Frank C. Alcorta

February 10, 1943 - August 23, 2017

Frank C. Alcorta, Jr., 74, of Somerset, Texas, went to rest with our Lord in Heaven late Tuesday night, August 23, 2017. He succumbed to his months-long illness, surrounded by family, at Mission Trails Baptist Hospital in San Antonio, Texas. Born on February 10, 1943 in Atascosa County, Frank was the first-born child of his beloved parents, Frank and Margarita Cruz Alcorta, in Somerset. He lived his early life in San Antonio, later moving to Kenosha, Wisconsin, where he worked for American Motors. He then returned to San Antonio, later choosing to reside in Somerset with his wife Bertha for their remaining years, where he worked for and retired with JCPenny as a custodian. Frank moved to Somerset to enjoy living the rest of his life on his small ranch, a piece of a much larger family property. His was a small portion of land, but it was his, and he made the most of it. Frank enjoyed being outdoors, maintaining his yard and keeping it green, watering the grass and plants, and growing fruit trees and flowered plants with Bertha. He loved wearing his jeans and boots, watching football and basketball, cheering for the Dallas Cowboys and San Antonio Spurs, of course. He loved his country music, eating some good tacos, and sitting on his front porch, reading the daily newspaper from start to finish, each day that he could. He was a simple man. Frank was preceded in death by his wife of 32 years, Bertha Alcorta, step-daughter Dolores Fuentes, and daughter Nancy Jo Alcorta. He is survived by his children, Shirley Alcorta and Mark Alcorta, along with step-children Michael Jeffcoat, Patricia Klassen, Diane De La Rosa, and John

Fuentes, and grandchildren and great grandchildren. He is also survived by his brothers and sisters, as well as nieces and nephews.

Visitation will be begin at 5:00 PM, with a 7:00 PM Rosary, on Thursday, August 31, 2017, at Palm Heights Mortuary. A Holy Mass will be held at 10:00 AM on Friday, September 1, 2017, at St. Mary's Catholic Church. Interment will follow at St. Patrick Cemetery in Somerset, TX.
