RETIRED FROM FALSTAFF BREWING COMPANY AS SALES REPRESENTATIVE AFTER 20 YEARS OF SERVICE. WORKED LATER FOR NUECES COUNTY COURTHOUSE AND LIBRARY. RESIDED IN SAN ANTONIO, McALLEN, AND CORPUS CHRISTI, TX. WIFE, MARY HELEN GUERRERO DECEASED. SURVIVED BY HIS CHILDREN, LINDA M. COULTER, FRANK G. HOLGUIN JR., MARK A. HOLGUIN, AND JAMES A. HOLGUIN.
