



Dr. Frank Richard Huster Jr.

July 27, 1919 - July 9, 2022

Dr. Frank Richard Huster, Jr., DVM was born in Philadelphia, PA on July 27, 1919 of Frank Richard Huster, Sr. and Madeline Dentone. He was preceded in death by parents, his wife, Miriam Lucille (Wilson) Huster, son, Steven Jeffery Huster, and daughter in law, Pauline Renata (Herr) Huster. He is survived by his daughter, Elizabeth Madeline (Jim) Olson, his granddaughter Cynthia Elizabeth (Shawn) Forrest, and two great granddaughters, Savannah and Shannon Forrest.

With his passing, the world has lost a magnificent husband, father, neighbor, friend and veterinary doctor. He was married to Miriam in Mexico City on December 28, 1951 for 56 years until her death on January 4, 2008. Frank joined Miriam on Saturday, July 9, 2022. He passed peacefully in his San Antonio cottage at Morningside Ministries, his bachelor pad where he was pampered by all and had his independence.

He graduated from the University of Pennsylvania and immediately was assigned to ship horses to Poland after the war, making over 15 trips from the US. Next, he found himself in Mexico fighting the Hoof and Mouth disease in conjunction with the USDA and Mexican militia. After the birth of Steven in New Orleans in 1952 he trained at Tulane University for another USDA endeavor in Egypt. In 1958, they moved to St. Louis and had Betsy then quickly moved to Ft. Worth in the Meat Packing industry. In 1961 later they

moved to Dream Hills Estates in San Antonio where he was assigned as a meat inspector of all South Texas. They later purchased Paradise Canyon, a swimming, fishing and picnicking park from 1970-1992. Subsequently, they built a log cabin from old telephone poles, scrap fencing and rocks from the canyon which was affectionately named the "pole house".

The funeral service will be held on Friday, July 22, at 9AM at the Tips Mausoleum on the grounds of Mission Park North Cemetery at 20900 IH 10W, San Antonio, TX 78257 followed by a graveside service.
