Frank C. Marquez, age 79, slipped into God's hands Wednesday, December 22, 2010. He and his twin brother, Joe, were born in San Antonio, Texas on July 19, 1931 to Jose and Maria Marquez. All three, father, mother and twin brother, preceded him in death. Frank is survived by his loving family: wife, Susan, sons, Robert Franki, Frank E.
