



## Frank Naranjo Sr. "Sonny"

November 21, 1946 - January 20, 2022

Frank Naranjo, Sr. of San Antonio, Texas passed away on January 20, 2022 at the age of 75.

Frank was born in Skidmore, Texas on November 21, 1946, to father, Gonzalo Naranjo and mother, Juanita Garcia. Being one of five siblings, he carved out his own path from his humble roots in South Texas and becoming a kind and loving Husband, Dad, Brother, Uncle and friend to many.
