Franklin Carter Wingate born on April 23, 1918 passed away on October 20, 2006 at the age of 88. Mr. Wingate served our country in the United States Army during World War II, a life member of the VFW American Legion Post 375, retired as a machinist from Kelly Air Force Base, NARF 1594 and was awarded a certificate of Merit in connection with military operation as a truck driver during period August 16 1944 to April 1945, Sgt. T.5. Franklin C. Wingate was appointed convoy leader, handling gasoline in Holland, Germany, France, and Belgium. His unblemished record of no accidents or mechanical failures and his conduct and reliability under all conditions merit the highest praise.
