



Fred Charles Anderson

September 9, 1917 - May 26, 2018

Fred Charles Anderson, 100, died Saturday May 26th, 2018 surrounded by family. He leaves behind his daughter Bonnie Anderson Yablonski (David); three grandchildren: Adam Yablonski (Jenna), Sarah Martinez (Isaac), and Amy Callaway (Adam); and five great-grandchildren along with numerous extended family and friends.

A native of San Antonio, Fred was born on September 9, 1917 to Sam Henry Anderson and Elba Babb Anderson on his family's "truck farm" where he grew up alongside his seven siblings. Fred had many adventures growing up on a farm and spent his mornings at the San Antonio Farmers Market with his father selling what they grew or raised. Fred attended Edgewood School and graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School in 1936.

Fred married Daisy Caldwell, the love of his life on November 15, 1940. They were married 75 years before her passing in 2015. Fred was a loving husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather and a faithful friend.

He served his country proudly during World War II and the Korean War.

An entrepreneur at heart, Fred was a pioneer in land development in the San Antonio area, including subdivisions and commercial real estate ventures in Lackland and Helotes.

Fred spent his best times on his ranch with his family, hunting and enjoying the outdoors.

He wrote numerous poems and stories about his life and his adventures growing up. His most recent poem, which won first place in a poetry contest, was written at the age of 100.

He is considered to be a legend by all who know him.

Visitation will be held Sunday, June 3, from 5-8 pm at Mission Park North. Memorial Services will be held Monday, June 4, at 9 am at Castle Hills Christian Church, 6209 West Ave. Graveside services will follow at San Fernando Cemetery #3 at the Anderson Family burial site.
