Fred Eugene Daniels, Sr. passed away from this life April 11, 2007. He was born in Paducah, KY October 9, 1924. His life and character epitomized the very essence of the Greatest Generation as he rose to meet life's challenges and faced adversity with extraordinary strength and perseverance. At the young age of 19 he was a commissioned AF pilot serving in World War II and made history as part of the Berlin Airlift.
