January 11, 1949 - February 24, 2016

Fred Lozano passed away February 24, 2016. He was 67. Fred was born on January 11, 1949 in San Antonio, TX. After graduating from Brackenridge HS and attending San Antonio College Fred dedicated over 40 years to a storied career in broadcast journalism. Beginning in 1970 at KONO radio, Fred moved into television to anchor the news at San Antonio's WOAI, spent two years reporting for KCBS in Los Angeles then returned to San Antonio to spend the next 35 years anchoring at KENS-TV garnering numerous awards, including two Emmys. Fred retired from broadcasting in 2012.

A self-taught musician, Fred spent his teenaged years performing in bands, including The Revells. His love of music stayed with him his entire life. He loved spending time with his family and friends and playing golf.

Fred was preceded in death by his parents Amalia and Federico Lozano. He is survived by sons Daniel, Robert and Jack; sisters Alice, Mary Helen and Terry; brother Rick; numerous nieces, nephews and cousins; and ex-wife and close friend Kelly Chapman Lozano.
