



## Frederick Joseph Petmecky

March 3, 1939 - June 23, 2021

Frederick Joseph Petmecky, age 82, was born March 3, 1939, in Fredericksburg, Texas, and passed from this earthly life into his heavenly home on June 23, 2021 in San Antonio, Texas.

On April 14, 2018 Fred married Vonda Fischer in San Antonio. She survives him. He is also survived by his brother Bill Petmecky, his daughter Kathy Dooley, her husband, Sean, and their two children, Nathan and Erin. Fred is predeceased by his wife of 46 years, Sheri Petmecky.

Fred graduated from Trinity University, and was involved with commercial real estate throughout his life.
