



## Frederick J. Ullrich

August 10, 1915 - March 21, 2011

Frederick John Ullrich Sr. Fritz joined his wife of 60 years , Marjorie Frey Ullrich in heaven on March 21, 2011 at the age of 95 years 7 months 11days. He was born August 10, 1915 to Louis and Lillie Kuehn Ullrich in San Antonio, TX. A native Texan, Fritz's ties go back to the German immigration of 1846 -1850.

He served in World War II with the 142 Division of the 36th Texas infantry as a Quartermaster in the African and European campaigns. He received the Soldier's Medal for heroism. When a box of phosphorous grenades fell from a truck burning two companions, he extinguished the box and rendered first aid until help arrived. Following the war Fritz returned to Boerne, TX and worked as a counterman and general shop helper at Sachs' Garage. It was in Boerne that he met Marjorie, who was staying with her Aunt Maria. After living in Boerne for several years Fritz and Margie moved to Austin where he worked as a counterman at Constant's Service Co. They made a big move to Farmington, CT in 1956 where he worked at the Pratt & Whitney Co. in Southington, CT. The winters were too cold for the native Texan and in 1958 they moved back to Texas and settled in San Antonio.

They moved on the 1st of September 1958 and have been living there ever since. In 1988 he retired from Strauss Frank Co. and his life-long career as an auto parts expert.

Fritz was a founding member of the parish of St Anthony de Padua. He served as an usher and on the parish council.

Beloved brother, father and grandfather, he is survived by his brother, David P. Ullrich, daughters, Virginia Ann Serna of Houston, Frances Marie Jones of Granger, Karen Louise Ullrich of Austin , Nancy Irene Allen Tony of Phoenix, AZ and his son Frederick John, Jr. of San Antonio, 10 grandchildren, and 9 great grandchildren, numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by 4 of his brothers, son-in-laws, Ronnie Jones and Tony Serna and granddaughter, Julee Ann Serna.
