Frieda Mae Blumer Shaddock, 88 years of age, passed into God's arms September 11, 2020. Frieda was born to Roman Clarence "R.C." Blumer and Vera Marguerite Elam Blumer May 11, 1932 in Pearland, Texas. She lived in Alvin, Texas, graduated from Alvin High School and worked in Houston, Texas at SouthWestern Bell as a telephone operator. After Frieda met the love of her life, LeeRoy Shaddock, whom she married June 2, 1956, they moved to San Antonio, Texas to start a life and family together, where God blessed them with 3 daughters. They lived and raised their family on a wonderful farm in Bracken, Texas. After the girls were in school, she worked alongside LeeRoy at Copy Products of San Antonio as an office technician. She eventually retired and took care of LeeRoy as his health declined and went onto Glory. Frieda was a grandmother of 6 and a great grandmother of 5. Most important of all, she was a devout servant of God, with a big giving heart.

Over the years Frieda was involved as a church member at Riverside Baptist Church and later at Northeast Baptist Church. She served God as a Sunday School teacher in various grades; young married, college & career, 3rd grade and preschool; a Vacation Bible School coordinator and teacher; Nursery Coordinator for infants and toddlers, taking the opportunity to be involved in

sharing God's love with every soul who crossed her path. She was also active in the Bracken Volunteer Fire Department Ladies Auxiliary and the community March of Dimes. She loved a good book, playing 42 and rousing games of Yahtzee, that could last most of the day or night. She was an avid Billy Graham, Dallas Cowboys and San Antonio Spurs fan, when there was a program or game on you might as well not call or make conversation, unless it was about the game or there was a Dr. Pepper, Hershey Kisses or a salty snack involved. Frieda relished her restaurant outings, mainly the Olive Garden or any get together with her family. She was known in the family for her banana pudding and coconut pies.

Frieda was preceded in death by her daughter, Peggy Shaddock, husband, LeeRoy Shaddock, mother and father, 2 brothers, Leigh and Lawrence Blumer, 1 sister, Anna Mary Sykora.
