Fronella "Fronie" Perrine Hess passed away Saturday, July 18th in Schertz, Texas. She was 87 years old, and was preceded in death by her husband John B. Hess, son William Brett Hess, brother Terry Gene Kirby, sister Mildred Kirby Hardgrave, and parents Oscar Perrine and Lola Mae Terry Perrine. She is survived by her brother John Perrine, sons Greg Jeanne, Mark, Kevin Betty, and Len; granddaughters Elaine Hess, Lauren Hess-Guzman, and Jenny Hess, and soon-to-be great-Granddaughter Delilah Elaine Hess. Fronie grew up in Goreville, IL during the great depression. She was only 10 years old when her mother passed away, and went to live with her sister Mildred in Lovington, IL, where she graduated from Lovington High School in 1943. She attended Murray State College University in Murray, KY and was a member of the Murray State Marching Band. It was in the band where she met her late husband John B. Hess. After living in Lawrenceville, Illinois, John and Fronie moved their family to San Antonio in 1963. Raising her boys was Fronie's passion, but she had always dreamed of becoming a nurse. After raising four successful boys, Fronie went back to college to become an RN. She worked as an RN for many years before retiring. After she retired, Fronie devoted many hours to volunteering at the hospital, and was a beloved member of the University Hospital Volunteer staff for a number of years. The funeral will be a grave-side service at Mission Park North Cemetery on I-10 at 10am Monday, July 27th.
