Following his service to our country he worked for Kelly AFB where he painted the sharks on warplanes and later retired in 1981. He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Oralia Luna. They were longtime members at St. Leonard's Catholic Church and played guitar in the Church choir for over 31 years.
