



## Gardis Weidman

July 14, 1915 - March 4, 2006

Gardis Weidman was born in Puckett, Mississippi, on July 14, 1915 to Richard and Melissa Maddox Ware. She died on March 4, 2006, in Albuquerque, New Mexico. She graduated from Centenary College in Shreveport, Louisiana. She married Chester Weidman, on August 5, 1936. She taught school in Olney, Childress, and Brownwood, Texas, before moving to San Antonio, Texas in 1949. She taught at Madison Elementary School in the SAISD and was principal at both Beacon Hill and Maverick elementary schools. She received her Master's Degree in Education and Administration from Trinity University. She retired from the SAISD in 1978. She was a member of the National Retired Teachers Association, Texas Retired Teachers Association, San Antonio Retired Teachers Association, Charter Member of the San Antonio Archives Association, Member of Tredda, Life Member of Texas PTA, Life Member of the WSCE of the Methodist Church, and member of Jefferson Methodist Church in San Antonio, Texas. She was preceded in death by her husband, Chester Weidman. She is survived by Daughter and husband, Chesta Ann and Dr. J.B.
