Garry L White PhD, twin brother of Larry White, passed away the morning of May 10, 2025 after an extended illness. He was two days away from his 75th birthday. Garry was very involved with his college fraternity, enjoyed hiking across the Grand Canyon, skiing, and caving. He was at peace, after all the visitors, cards and voice messages. This all touched him deeply. Garry you will be missed.

Garry's funeral will be on Friday, May 30, 2025, at Mission Park Cemetery-South, 1700 SE Military Dr. San Antonio. 78214. Visitation starts at 10 am, Funeral starts at 11 am with a lunch/reception to follow at the Cemetery's banquet hall. Please pass this onto those who may want to go to his funeral.

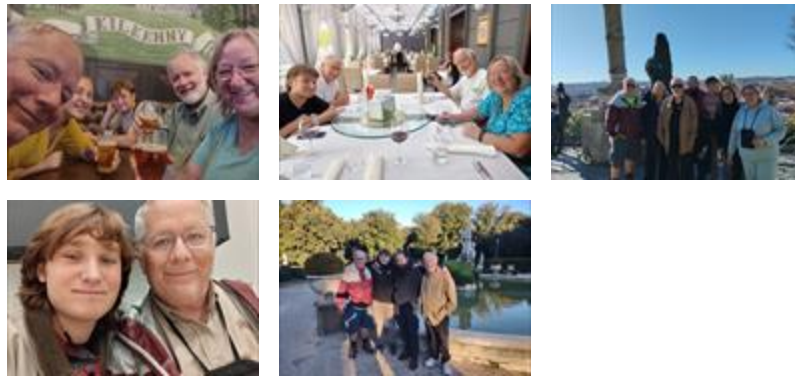

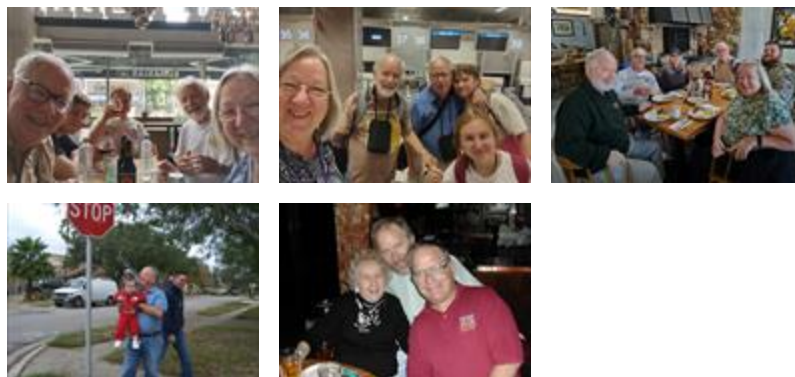

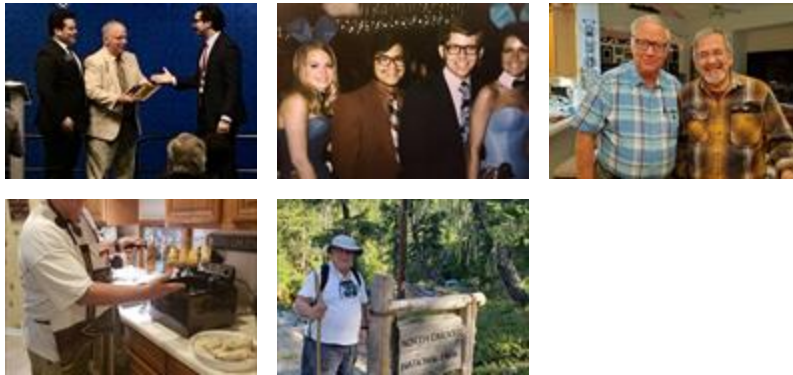
