



Garry Woo

August 4, 1957 - May 1, 2026

Garry Woo, M.D., 68, passed away on May 1, 2026, at Baylor Scott & White Medical Center in Irving, Texas.

Born in San Antonio, he was the son of Joe W. Woo and Susan D. Woo. He attended St. Martin's Hall, Central Catholic High School, and St. Mary's University, all in San Antonio.

Dr. Woo was an Internal Medicine physician who practiced in Public Health and General Preventive Medicine for more than 40 years. After graduating with honors in 1984 from the University of Texas Medical School at San Antonio, he began his medical career at the San Antonio State Chest Hospital within the Texas Department of Health, where he served for approximately 10 years. He later became the Dallas County Medical Director for Tuberculosis Prevention, where he and his staff managed approximately 95% of the tuberculosis cases in Dallas County, Texas.

Dr. Woo was a devoted member of St. Ann Catholic Parish in Coppell, Texas and was active in his neighborhood homeowners' association.

He is survived by his sisters, Annette Woo; Jeannette Boerner and her husband, Jerry; and Lornnette Zatopek and her husband, Dan; along with six nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and his

brother, Larry Woo.

A funeral service will be held on Saturday, May 16, at 1:00 p.m. at Mission Park Funeral Chapels South.
