Gay Richardson, 94, of Boerne, Texas, passed away on August 2, 2025. He was born on October 22, 1930, in Tahoka, Lynn County, Texas. After retiring in 1968 in San Antonio, Texas, Gay began a second career as chief radiology technician for what is now South Texas Radiology and Imaging Center.
